The Archives Portal serves as the online counterpart to the Pittsburgh Symphony Archives located at Heinz Hall. Search the online archives for digitized copies of photographs, programs, posters, and audio highlights. The Archives Portal allows visitors to search the Pittsburgh Symphony's performance history dating back to its start in 1896.
