With candied lime peel, lemon, and mineral notes on the nose, this white offers bright, juicy acidity that is balanced by green apple freshness, peach and hints of mango on the finish.

**2012 Mercer
Canyons Chardonnay**

Sweet vanilla and pineapple juice lead into honeysuckle and floral notes on the nose. Ample fruit is balanced with a note of minerality to create an elegant, balanced wine.

**2012 Chateau
Ste. Michelle Indian
Wells Merlot**

This Merlot has plum, currant and chocolate on the nose. With currant, cherries, tobacco and cedar flavors, it also has a full dose of sweet oak. It finishes with a supple density.

**2011 Mercer
Canyons
Red Blend**

With cherries, plums and notes of vanilla and tobacco, this blend has plush fruit and structured tannins in the mid-palate leading into a long finish with notes of cherry and spice.
