

2011 Chalk Hill Sauvignon Blanc

With a nose of pineapple, lychee, pear, orange blossoms and thyme, this white has Meyer lemon, apricot, grapefruit and nectarine flavors with a juicy, spicy finish that has a touch of spices and crushed rock.

2010 Marimar Estate Chardonnay

This white has a nose of gardenia and honeysuckle, plus a minerality reminiscent of wet pebbles, and a burst of citrus. A note of hazelnut and spice from the elegant oak carries through on the palate.

2010 Sebastini Merlot

With sour cherry and oak spice on the nose, this wine also has kirsch and hints of tomato. It is a dry red with flavors of currant, herb, vanilla, oak and a bit of olive brine and Crème de Cassis liqueur.

2010 Chateau St. Jean Cabernet Sauvignon

Ripe with aromas of blackberries, cloves, plum and chocolate, this red boasts dark berry fruits with notes of black tea and brown spice with a long finish.
