

2012 Yealands Sauvignon Blanc

With aromas of dried thyme, spice, and blackcurrant, this wine has citrus notes of lime and tons of pink grapefruit with wet stone, nettle and a mineral acidity that all come together in perfect harmony.

2010 Coopers Creek Riesling

With a golden green color, this wine displays green apple, and subtle chalky characters on the nose. On the palate, this medium bodied wine shows crisp acidity and candied lemon with tropical notes and a spry finish.

2010 Coopers Creek Pinot Noir

With a dense core and a ruby red rim, this wine has aromas of red and black fruits and a touch of oak. Typically round and supple, with just enough tannin to give overall structure, there are masses of sweet fruit on the finish.

2011 Tait Ball Buster Shiraz Blend

With a purple color, this wine shows blueberry, licorice and wood smoke on the nose. On the palate, it is smooth and sweet, offering black raspberry and cola flavors with a hint of bitter chocolate and black pepper.
