

**2010 Château de  
Lascaux Coteaux du  
Languedoc Rosé**

It has a pale rose color and a nose of raspberries and strawberries that carry over to the palate with a bit of citrus and a slightly dry finish.

**2008 Clos La  
Coutale Cahors**

With an inky dark red color, this wine has a rich nose of dark red fruits and a bit of licorice and toffee. It is full of tannins and blackberry fruit with a dry finish.

**2010 Château Saint  
Martin de la Garrigue  
Picpoul de Pinet**

With lemon zest on the nose, this wine starts with a bright crisp acidity and opens into a mint-and-verbena-scented, powerfully lemony wine.

**2009 Ermitage  
du Pic Saint Loup  
Tour de Pierres**

With a nose of spice and blackberry, this wine has a wonderful sweetness on the palate as well as great tannins and a long finish.
