GENERAL AUDITION INFORMATION

Please read all of this information carefully, and retain for your future reference. All questions regarding the audition and this information must be directed to the Orchestra Personnel Office only. We request that you do not contact members of the audition committee. The preferred method of contact is by email to auditions@pittsburghsymphony.org.

To apply for this audition, please **submit the online application** form on the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra's (PSO) web site at: www.pittsburghsymphony.org/auditions on or before the **deadline of Friday, September 7th**. Please await confirmation of your audition before making travel plans. The Preliminary and Semi-Final rounds of auditions are scheduled for November 4-7, 2018 at Heinz Hall, 600 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15222. Note that a Semi-Final round will take place following the Preliminary round each day on November 4 through 7. The invited Semi-Final round and Final round will take place Monday, November 26, 2018.

Invitations are sent by email, typically within one week after the resume deadline. You will receive further information regarding instrument specifications at this time. Note that recorded auditions may be required of candidates. A repertoire list for the recording is included in this document, and details on recording format will be made available along with invitations. Deposit checks will not be required for this audition, but we kindly ask you to show courtesy to the audition committee by letting us know at least ten days prior to the audition date if you will not attend.

All candidates must play on the PSO timpani, which are: Adams Classics with Remo Hazy Heads. We will provide two sets: one American, and one set up German. Additional details on instruments for the audition and warm up will be provided with audition invitations.

POSITION DETAILS

The PSO's Principal Timpani position begins Tuesday, September 3, 2019, or per mutual agreement of the PSO and the winning candidate. Pay is at least minimum orchestra weekly scale of \$1,907.63. This position may negotiate for additional weekly overscale (pay) related to the duties of Principal Timpani.

Musicians hired by the PSO are responsible for having and maintaining authorization to be employed in the United States of America, and to travel on international tours as a musician with the PSO. The PSO will act as sponsor for visa petitions for musicians who are offered or have positions as members of the orchestra, however it is the musician's responsibility to bear all costs associated with the petition and meet all required deadlines.

VIDEO RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS

- o The "Recorded Audition Repertoire List" should be performed start to finish in **one take with no edits.**
- o The entire list should be played on one set of four drums.
- o The camera should be in one fixed position for the entire performance.
- o The camera should be placed in a wide shot directly facing the performer, with all four drums completely visible from the pedals up.
- o The performer must remain in the frame throughout the performance.
- o The microphone may be placed anywhere you like.
