GENERAL AUDITION INFORMATION

To apply for this audition, please **send your one-page resume in PDF format** on or before the deadline of **Monday**, **February 18**, **2019** to <u>librarian audition@pittsburghsymphony.org</u>. Further details may be found on the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra's (PSO) website at www.pittsburghsymphony.org/auditions.

Invitations are sent by email, typically within one week of the resume deadline. Candidates may be asked to participate in screening interviews to be held by phone and through email in early March 2019. Live auditions are scheduled for April 1 and 2, 2019, at Heinz Hall, 600 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15222. Finalists may be asked for additional live interviews in Pittsburgh between May 8 and 17, 2019.

Please await confirmation of your live audition before making travel plans.

POSITION DETAILS

The PSO's Assistant Librarian position begins September 3, 2019, or per the mutual agreement of the PSO and the winning candidate. This position is a member of the orchestra and included in the orchestra's bargaining unit. Pay for the 2019-2020 season is at least minimum orchestra weekly scale of \$1,945.78.

Please note that a minimum of two years' experience as a librarian for a professional orchestra is desired.

Musicians hired by the PSO are responsible for having and maintaining authorization to be employed in the United States of America, and to travel on international tours as a musician with the PSO. The PSO will act as sponsor for visa petitions for musicians who are offered or have positions as members of the orchestra, however it is the musician's responsibility to bear all costs associated with the petition and meet all required deadlines.
