### **Job Purpose**

The purpose of this position is to welcome and create the first impression for patrons while directing customer flow through screening checkpoints lines to ensure order, safety, and efficiency.

# **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Act as the first point of contact for patrons as they enter the building, providing a warm customer-oriented experience
  - Provide directions and respond to patron inquiries with a consistent customer service tone
  - Monitor line length and direct patrons to ensure order, safety, and efficiency
  - Maintain a professional appearance and a courteous attitude towards all guests and staff at all times

## Required Education, Experience and Abilities:

- Highschool Diploma or GED
- Experience working directly with the public
- Outstanding customer services skills
- Able to handle the stress of high customer demand in a hospitality environment
- Ability to work independently and/or with others as needed
- Ability to maintain composure and perform well under pressure
- Ability and willingness to work irregular hours, including evenings and/or weekends

### **Physical Requirements:**

- Ability to be mobile for extended periods of time
- Ability to quickly analyze visual information
- Ability to quickly reach decisions regarding the directing the flow of large groups of people
